



# CS3208 Interim Progress Report

## *Submission Guidelines for Students*

**This write-up is meant for students doing CS3208 (but excluding students in the CS3208-CS4101 track). Students in the CS3208-CS4101 track should submit their final reports according to the CS3209 guidelines.**

The CS3208 Interim Progress Report is a short report (6-10 pages) that covers:

- your project description;
- your progress made so far; and
- your research plan for the next semester (CS3209).

You should check with your supervisor on the best way to present your work and progress in this report.

You should submit a hard copy to your supervisor and a soft copy to the IVLE Workbin by the deadline.

The Interim Progress Report will be used as a basis for your supervisor to decide whether or not you have made sufficient progress to continue to CS3209.

If your supervisor agrees that you continue the project,

- you will be automatically registered for CS3209 next semester; and
- you will receive an “IP” grade for CS3208 this semester.

If however, your supervisor decides that you have not made sufficient progress and discontinues the project, we will arrange for you to hold a presentation so that you can be evaluated on your work for CS3208. You would also need to submit a more detailed report to conclude your CS3208 project. You will be given a grade for CS3208.
