The Effect: The Invisible Cup

When there is no motion involving the cup, we use a clean plate of the background to remove the unwanted portion of the cup. We will then have to do cleaning to the remaining portion to remove reflections.

When there is motion, eg pouring coffee into cup and human interacting with cup, we will take the footages in front of a blue screen, and composite the foreground onto the background. Similarly, we will use the clean plate to remove unwanted portions of the cup and clean off reflections.

To clean off reflections, we intend to build a cross section model of the coffee intensity. We will then replace the reflections with the calculated coffee intensity. We will need to further investigate the properties of coffee from our trial video footages to build a good model of the coffee intensity.


The Story


The main character goes to the pantry/kitchen to fetch a drink, but he is unable to find a cup. So, he takes out his magic pen to draw an invisible cup.

With his invisible cup, the main character pours his coffee to drink. After his drink, he takes out his magic pen again to erase off the invisible cup.




