

ER2004 Author Guidelines

The ER2004 proceedings will be published by Springer-Verlag in the LNCS series. Springer-Verlag publishes a full-text electronic version of LNCS in parallel with the printed version, thus the electronic source of accepted papers is required (Springer-Verlag strongly prefers the LaTeX 2e format, but Word format is acceptable). See the Springer site (<http://www.springeronline.com/sgw/cda/frontpage/0,10735,5-164-2-72376-0,00.html>) for author instructions. **Please follow the author instructions carefully.**

Be sure to respond to referee comments in revising your camera-ready papers.

The page limits of research papers, workshop papers, and industrial papers are 14, 12, and 3 pages respectively. Extra pages are available for \$150 per page up to 4 pages.

Please send your camera-ready papers to the publication chair by **August 14** (Deadline for Workshop papers may be a few days late, which depends on the final announcement of Workshop Co-chairs). You must send both a printed copy and an electronic copy of your paper. Please send the hardcopy (on U.S. letter or A4 paper) to:

When sending the hardcopy, please mark on the envelope the type (e.g. Research paper, Industrial paper, Workshop name) and the number of your paper.

Please upload your electronic copy as a compressed archive via ftp site: **61.129.42.95**. Account and password to access the ftp site will be sent by another

email. You are recommended to use the zip software to compress your documents, and please send only a single archive file. For authors using a word processor, send the original file. For authors using LaTeX, send all the files needed to compile your paper. Also include a PDF or PostScript copy of the paper.

Please name your archive according to your paper type and number. For examples:

- 1) Research paper 101, named as "er2004-research-101.zip";
- 2) Industrial paper 012, named as "er2004-industrial-012.zip";
- 3) Workshop CoMoGIS paper 021, named as "comogis-paper-021.zip".

Springer requires a signed copyright form with each paper. Only one author needs to sign the copyright form. Visit the Springer Web site (<http://www.springeronline.com/sgw/cda/frontpage/0,10735,5-164-2-72376-0,00.html>) to get the copyright form. For the first two fields of the copyright form, if your paper is ER research / industrial paper, write the following:

Conference/Book: ER2004 Conference Proceedings Volume Editors: Lu, Atzeni, Chu, Zhou, and Ling

If your paper belongs to a certain ER2004 Workshop, write the following:

Conference/Book: ER2004 Workshop Proceedings Volume Editors: Wang, Tanaka, et al

At least one author of each accepted paper is required to register for the ER2004 Conference by **August 14**. Students registered as author registrations must pay full fee, not discounted student registration fee.
