

The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. 1 Corinthians 12:12





(2) Why is it important to use our talents? Why does God give us different talents?


(3) Write down two ways in which you can use your talents to serve your GB company and at home. Try fulfilling them in the new week ahead!







































