

# Guide to Using Software (1)


- Go to the main page
- Login with the given username and password
- Click on “Add Essay” to start
- Enter an essay or load a .doc/.docx in the pop-up screen



- Click the “Add Essay” button when the essay is completed

# Guide to Using Software (2)

- You should now see your essay in the “View Essays” list
- Select “Annotate” under “Operations”





# Guide to Using Software (3)

- Click on “Auto Grammar Check” to activate the grammar checker




- This can take some time depending on the essay length
- The system will then highlight the detected grammatical errors



# Guide to Using Software (4)


- Left click on a highlighted word to see the proposed correction and sample usage

# Guide to Using Software (5)

- Click on “Show Sample Usage” to bring up the original and corrected version of the sentence
- Click on one of the highlighted words to display sentences (retrieved from a large text corpus) that are most similar to the original sentence near the detected error and to the corrected sentence near the suggested correction
