Getting Started

These are VIZ basic features that you need to know to get you started...

To analyze a newly recorded RunLog files:

1. Click menu 'File-New Viz File...'
The Viz Raw-to-Visual Data Conversion Wizard appears...
2. Follow the instruction on the screen...
Note that there are separate help files for that wizard!!
After the conversion is done, the resulting Viz visual data file is presented :)

To load a visual data file or visual presentation file:

1. Click menu 'File-Open Viz File...'
2. Pick one of the pre-computed Viz visual data file: *.viz

To 'Play/Pause/Stop/Scroll' the search playback:

1. Click the respective buttons or slide the iteration/time bar, as in Windows Media Player...
2. Play around with the various adjustable things in ControlPanel and see the effects to the visualizations...
3. The meaning/interpretation of each visualization is described in the individual help files...

That's all

Happy analyzing your stochastic/heuristic local search :)

Btw, due to VIZ complexity in displaying the information, VIZ is best viewed using screen resolution of 1024*768 or higher...
