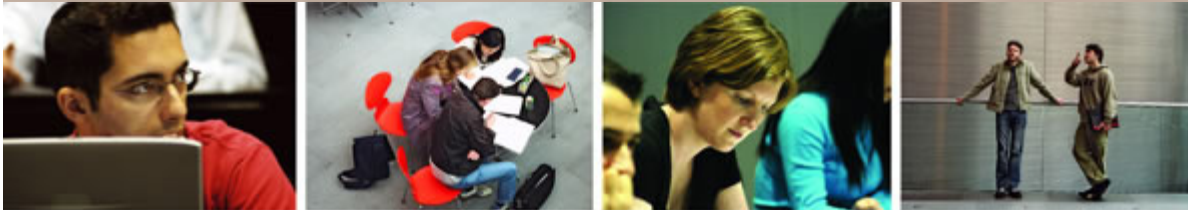


## Alumni Network

The Guest of Honour is Mr. Lim Hua Min, an alumnus of Imperial College London, who is founder and chairman of Philip Securities. He graduated with a MSc degree in Operations Research & Management Studies from Imperial College in 1969. Mr. Lim is concurrently the Executive Chairman of the PhillipCapital Group of Companies. He began his career holding senior positions in the Stock Exchange of Singapore and the Securities Research Institute. He has served on a number of committees and sub-committees of the Stock Exchange of Singapore. In 1997, he was appointed Chairman of the Stock Exchange of Singapore ("SES") Review Committee, which was responsible for devising a conceptual framework to make Singapore's capital markets more globalised, competitive and robust. For this service, he was awarded the Public Service Medal in 1999 by the Singapore Government. He has served as a board member in the Inland Revenue Authority of Singapore and as a member in the Resource Panel of the Government Parliamentary Committee for Finance & Trade & Industry.
