The attendance figs for the 4 progs are as follows:

- Stem Cells in the Regeneration of Human Musculoskeletal System : 92 pax
- Workshop on Assistive Technologies: 24 pax
- These Legs are Made for Walking: 40 pax
- Panel Discussion: "Making the Six Million Dollars Man": 93 pax

In all, there were 249 participants for this series. Based on the written feedback we received, 93.2% of the respondents (on average) rated the programmes as 'Good' or 'Excellent'. The accolades received included the following:
