USE OF CALCULATORS IN EXAMINATIONS

- 1. Where calculators are allowed to be used in the examinations, candidates may bring in any hand-held battery operated, noiseless, non-programmable, scientific/functional calculator without print-out facilities. Any programmable calculators, palm-top PCs, electronic organisers/digital diaries/dictionaries and notebook computers will not be allowed. Programmable calculators are basically calculators that can store formulas so that they can be recalled and used. They usually have the "Go" and "Run" buttons.
- 2. A candidate who brings into the examination hall items that do not comply with the above instruction would be deemed to have committed an act of cheating. Disciplinary action will be taken against him accordingly.
- 3. Candidates must ensure that their calculators are in good working condition. Requests for replacements arising from calculator breakdowns during an examination will not be entertained.
- 4. There will not be any checking, registering or stamping of calculators prior to the examination. Candidates do not need to go to the different departments to have their calculators verified.
- 5. No candidate may claim special consideration for non-possession of a calculator, malfunctioning of a calculator or for inability to use a calculator.
- 6. Calculators used in an examination room must be without covers.
