History of Singapore

13th and 14th Century: Independent country;
Last Sultan Iskander Shah fled to Malacca after defeat,
founding new country there;
Belonged to Sultanate of Johor, gunned down 1613 by
Portuguese;
1819: Sir Stamford Raffles landed in Singapore and
founded port, Britain acquired over decades more and more
rights to the island;
1941-1945: Singapore occupied by Japan, dark time of
history;
1963: Singapore transferred from Britain to Malaysia;
1965: Singapore independent, gradually growing to city
occupying all of its island.
Over 5 Million inhabitants as of now.

History of NUS

1905: Founded as Medical College;

1949: Merging with Raffles College making it into a university;

1980: Merging with Nanyang University to become National University of Singapore (a new institution named Nanyang Technological University was founded later);

2025: Approximately 35K students

1975: Department of Computer Science of Nanyang University founded and became 1980 part of NUS;

1998: Founding of own faculty in NUS, named School of Computing;

2025: Today one of the biggest faculties of NUS.
